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


Movin'On Lucrezio de Seta Quartet Ettore Carucci - Gianni Denitto - Leonardo De Rose




"Lucrezio de Seta's new release Movin' On is a powerful musical statement, an emotionally charged and expressive take on improvised idioms.

Movin On Lycrezio de Seta Quartet Ettore Carucci - Gianni Denitto - Leonardo De Rose

"For drummer and producer Lucrezio de Seta the CD "Movin' On" is a turning point, a challenge to realize, in his own words: "that which has always been deepest in my heart, namely jazz in its most radical, progressive and broadest sense".

The result is an inspired album, in which every theme and every solo is animated by an intention that renders the music current, present and alive. For the occasion, de Seta has abandoned his preferred formation, the trio, replacing it with the unbridled and flexible sound of a quartet capable of expressing the vast array of material on the CD while maintaining a precise identity. The ballad, "Giochi di Ombre", the suite for percussion, "Seguendo la Luna Laerte veleggiò verso Levante", the two Oriental inspired pieces, "Suresh" and "Vedanta", and the jazz standard, "You don't know what Love is", are pearls of a work richly teeming with ideas in which de Seta has managed to achieve a tasteful balance between written and improvised passages. In this set consisting of clear and seductive melodies, finely tuned arrangements and interplay at the highest levels, each musician contributes freely with personality: Gianni Denitto ignites the themes

of the compositions with the creamy sound of his sax, expanding the harmonic spaces with his solos; pianist Ettore Carucci creating introductions, suspending themes, releases himself in solos and accompanies with a strong rhythmic/percussive drive; Leonardo De Rose's bass sustains and enhances the entire architecture. De Seta incites, contains and steers the ensemble, reserving the suite "Seguendo La Luna..." and the piece "Die Rückker der Goetter".



"Lyricism and feeling in music are the direct consequence of expressiveness and knowing how to communicate. They are components that surpass any technical term, any pretense of emulation, any purely instrumental and earthly desire, they are the sublimation that touches the divine, or for agnostics, the confine between craftsmanship and art that every authentic musician pursues after a life of study. The only true, universal reasons for which it is always worthwhile making music beyond any sacrifice. We are all servants like Bach, Mozart, Haydn, Beethoven a at times inspired, at times faltering, but always striving.

After opening with a K.Wheeler "cover" which the piano articulates with an outstandingly decisive, rhythmic symbiosis, it arrives at almost intimist compositions that seem to make up the central nucleus of the album. Through their individual contributions, the quartet fully expresses the meaning of the words, "continual mutation". The investigation of various thematic cores can be felt in the musical fabric, and they are given form in turn by Ettore Carucci's piano, Gianni Denitto's sax, Leonardo de Rose's contra bass and the drums of Lucrezio de Seta. The fluid interplay of the instruments creates continually changing atmospheres and visions, mutations in the intrinsic nature of the musical material. The spirit of the whole recording is felt, at times, charged with rhythmic tension, now captivating, then compelling, with a sense of perpetual boundlessness, with episodes of intense authentic lyricism. Everywhere there are traces of truly intense jazz, but we are instead in the environment of contemporary music; in part propelling, enchanting, lyrical and luminescent."

"Terse and seductive melodies, arrangements measured with cure, interplay at his best. Movin' ON is an inspired album: every theme, every solo is liven up from a deep prupose that makes the music extant, current and alive. The ballad "Playtime", the suite for percussion "Seguendo la Luna Laerte veleggio verso Levante", the two tunes of Vedic inspiration, "Suresh" and "Vedanta", the Jazz standard "You don't know what love is" are the pearls of an album full of ideas and intense, that goes straight to the heart. The Lucrezio de Seta Quartet has an overflowing and flexible sound, able to enhance the variety of the auditory materials keeping a strong identity.



BIO:

Gianni is among the best musician of the 2012 according to the Referendum of the famous "Musica Jazz" magazine" (Pino Candini Award), yet among the best italian talents in the 2011 and 2010

At the age of 18, Gianni plays the clarinet in the "Torino Philarmone Orchestra". With the rock band inspired to Frank Zappa "Ossi Duri" he plays the clarinet, the sax, the guitar and the effects, recording in the 2003 the album "X, ten years Later" on the occasion of 10th anniversary of the Frank Zappa death with Mike Keneally, Ike Willis, Claudio Bisio and "Gnam Gnam" (2005) with Elio, the front man of "Elio e Le Storie Tese" band. With the Phone Regis band he starts to explore the field of the digital sound winning the "Non Solo Rock" award and the "Piceno on the Rock" award (2003), playing also with Morgan and Planet Funk.
